


# 1. Sorghum is the 5<sup>th</sup> cereal in the world

Sorghum is the 5<sup>th</sup> cereal produced in the world after corn, wheat, rice and barley.

Sorghum world's production is relatively steady since the 70s with between 60 MMT and 70 MMT produced each marketing year.

## 2. World uses for grain sorghum


World sorghum grain main uses:


-Food: around 60%

-Feed: around 40%

-Industrial: around 10%

These last decades, uses for food are growing due to an increase in population in Africa and Asia while industrial and feed uses are steadier and more dependent on cereals prices evolutions.

Main sorghum producing regions (2016-2020) and % of total world production

-Africa : ~ 50%

Nigeria, Ethiopia, Sudan...

-North America: 24%

USA, Mexico

-South and East Asia: 13%

China, India

-South America: 9%

Argentina, Brazil


-Europe: 1%

EU (France, Italy), Ukraine

-Oceania: 2%

Share of world imports and exports by region (mean 2016-2020)


3 main exporters: USA, Argentina, Australia


-USA: 70% to 80% of total world exports
Regional exporters: Ukraine, India, Ethiopia...

1 major importer: China

-China: 85% and growing fast Other important importers: EU (Spain, Italy...), Mexico, Japan...

Around 8 Mt and 12% of world production exported each year.


### 5. The USA: world top exporter

The USA is world's largest sorghum exporter for decades.

The USA exported on average 5,2 MMT these last 5 marketing years.

USA exports represent on average 70% to 80% of the world sorghum exports.

# 6. China: a new and major sorghum importer


China is a major sorghum importer since 2012/13.


China imported on average 5,4 MMT these last 5 marketing years, making it world's 1st sorghum importer.

China is the USA main buyer. It imports around 80 to 90% of its needs from the USA.

China needs for grain sorghum are growing fast:

- -increase in feed demand
- -a desire to diversify agricultural supplies and suppliers


## Sorghum in Europe

Still a "niche market"...

~ 550 000 ha in 2021 (Sorghum-ID Estimate)

60% grain - 40% silage

50% EU – 50% non-EU countries













# Seed Sorghum: more than 2000 ha in the EU

Continuous increase from 2016 to supply the market x 5 in 6 years

Record area 2021: 2155 ha!



#### Main sorghum seed producing countries in the EU








# France: 1<sup>st</sup> seed sorghum producer in the EU

940 ha in 2021

189 seed sorghum growers

More than 80 varieties produced (350 registered in the EU Catalogue)

Yield: between 2 and 3 T/ha







# France: 1<sup>st</sup> sorghum seed exporter in the EU

~ 1550 T sorghum exported (3 y. average):

46% Southern EU

26% Central and Eastern EU

12% Northern EU

10% Ukraine and Russia

6% Others

Increasing trend: +18% in 2021


### Seed availability: EU still need imports

#### France's sorghum seed import (T)

5140 T seed sorghum imported in France for sowing 2021: +63%

X3 in 2 years!

75% from North America (USA mainly)



Increasing market means increasing seed demand

Low seed availability to supply the market over the last 3 sowing campaign

But positive signals for upcoming sowing:

- Increasing ressources
   (multiplication area, yield, imports)
- Slight decrease of uses 2021
- Increasing carry-over and seed availability for sowing in 2022.
